Dick does not remember when it was built (it had no date) but remembers its first tenant as being Borbridge Harness, a harness manufacturer. (From L.A.S. conversation with R. Town, June 13, 1977.)

Borbridge Western Ltd. had extensive contracts with Canadian Army Cavalry during WWI.

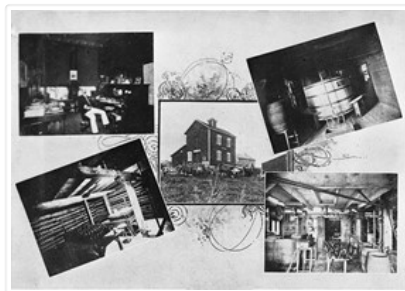
