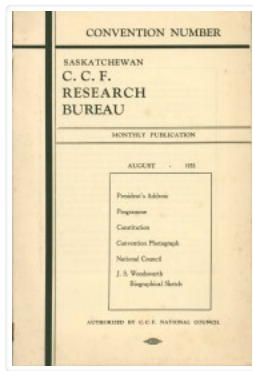

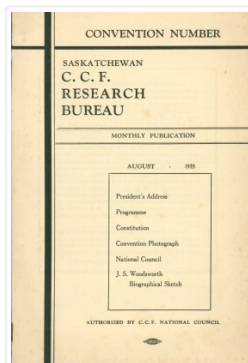


First annual C.C.F. convention, Regina, July 19, 20, 21, 1933
