Overcast all day. Haven't had a chance to write notes yet. Spent a lot of time in K&K cleaning pedestals in L5.

x410 Lauren → showed up late today. Working on SWQ L4. IP'able base in floor, small pcs FCR, bbf's, charcoal. Says soil is "looser" "not as compacted" in SWQ.

x411 Emily → Working on last quadrant of L5 (NWQ). Bone pedestalled in after 3 quads. Dramatic soil change at bottom of level. Goes from 10yr 3/2 (or close) to very light. Looks almost ashy, but doesn't really feel like it. More pronounced in E 1/2 of unit, esp. NEQ. Small amount FCR, just a couple of flakes. The soil change may be evidence of the least soil "E" horizon.

x412 Denise → Finished N 1/2 of L6. Broken rib pedestalled in NEQ. Skeletal in NWQ. Looks like a scraper with perhaps matches for bedding. Very cool. #6 green chert. 12-6-5. Northwest corner of NWQ is very light, the darker spot between NEQ and NWQ. ~~the~~ Purer soil might just be differential drying.

x413 Erica → Working on SWQ L7. Soil change is started in L6, continuing in L7. Very light sands. Not very much in L7.

x414 Chris → Just finished L8. N 1/2 of unit completely sterile. Some flakes in each of 5 quads. ECR in SE bank. Hopefully we'll get him on a shovel soon.

x415 Day -> Just finished L4. Packed by FCR from NW bank. Smaller roots still. Lots of Plakes, esp. in W quads. SRC & BCL. No F.P. Able here in floor.

x416 Day -> Working on SEQ of L5. Not too many artifacts, just small pcs FCR and some Plakes. Bare in floor of L5.

Didn't get a chance to make any notes at Creeper yesterday, so I'm getting caught up now.



X41 Michelle -> Working on last quad of L6 (SWQ). Thoracic spine along N Wall. Lots of bts, ~~in all quads~~ esp in W/2. Will beat L8 by the end of the day.

X42 Mike -> Has encountered more lg IPable bone in L7. Working on NWQ. Lots going into L8. Has considerably skinned Mike down. No flakes noticed so far, no pottery. Small concentric FCR. Actually, I think of more IPable bone over in L6

X43 Becker -> Working on SWQ L5. Through most of the roots. Floors aren't bad, but things aren't moving very quickly. Found a chunk of pottery in her NW bank yesterday. It turned out to be a fairly large rim sher.

3-4-11. I don't have it here, but from memory it looks something like this:

Baby was able to find another pc in a quad bag yesterday that looks like part of the same vessel. N/S from SE quad. Flakes, bits throughout.

X44 Lynette → Just starting last quad of L5 (SEQ). Bone protruded in other 3 quads. Soil change visible in SWQ where we want to drop some carapace/terrors visible. Upper <sup>(pc)</sup> mandible in NWQ that extends into X45. Some sort of rock in SEQ that doesn't look like FCR. There are, however, some small pcs of FCR.

X45 Katie → Working on 1<sup>st</sup> quad of L6 (WSEQ). Has uncovered a 2<sup>nd</sup> piece of mandible that seems to go under the 1<sup>st</sup> piece. Either some strange disturbance or deposition here. Seems to be less bits than L5. Think soil change here. The next level of light sand should have significantly less objects in it. There is a meta-podiat in the SWQ that we will take for an PC sample. Some small pcs of pottery in L5. Not a lot of flakes.

sub Steve → Working on 1<sup>st</sup> quad of L5 (NWQ). Beginning to find identifiable bone and FCR in this level. I hope that the excavation is at least kind of neat.

This part of the site is starting to look somewhat like a processing area. Quite a few flakes, throw-away bone elements, FCR. Mostly different from the skinned area that was excavated in 2003, where the backfill pile is now. Earlier, I had a theory that the elevated area represented habitation.

2000 0213 -> Working on 17 tracks on the end of the hole. Look up from floor. Tracks, evidence of a hole in floor found by the water table. Below the water table, still a hole. Should be done by track

Thurs June 6/05

Didn't get any notes done yesterday. Spent the morning screen slaving for Chris M. and Erin L. at the Crepe site. In the afternoon I helped clean their walls and profiles. Chris is now finished and will work with Erin to get her done by coffee break today.

Graham Site 8:15 am

X42 Michelle → Found a rimstone in the screen from EQ L7 (1-7-13). Lots of plates in L7. Mostly brown chert. Bone visible in floor on W side of unit. Found possible avian femur. Is working on Becky's unit to get someone down to the blue bed that is best exposed in Mike's unit (X42).  
L7 photos are Graham 100-25, 26, 31, 32.

X42 Mike → Finished L7 yesterday. Lots of IP bone in floor. Scapulae, radius, ulnae, humeri (distal), vert. Articulated batobovis unit (Fordog). Photos Graham 100-22, 23, 24, 31, 32. Almost all bone will be pedastalked through L8. Working on Becky's unit (X43) to get someone to the blue bed.

X43 Becky → Working on L7 with Mike and Michelle. Lots of IP bone in floor. Furrows, ribs, vert. Point in NWQ found by Mike yesterday.

x45 Katie → Working on SWQ L7. Mandible, dist. humerus, FCR, metatarsal, radius predated from L6. Found N skeds, oxidized body, in L6. Photo L6 is Graham 100-21.

x46 Steve → Working on NWQ L6. Rib, calcaneus, FCR, LBF's predated from L5. Found another pipe frag in L5. Graham 100-027. Steve missed the bus this morning. Wheeps.

Crepes 9:15 am

x410 Lauren → 1/2 way through L6. Nothing in N 1/2. Didn't actually find that much in the whole unit, so I don't know why it's taking so long. Denise is fixing her walls, especially the south. Soil is definitely lighter at the bottom of L6.

x411 Emily → She's on the shard and 3/4 through L8. L7 was a/most sterile. Both L7 & L8 are very light sand. She should get most of the way done today if we can get her a screen slave.

x412 Denise → Peter travelling through L9. One ~~thin~~ largeish flake in L8 and bf's. Should be on a shovel at the end of this level. Soil change at bottom of L8.

x413 Erica → Just finished profiling S & E walls. Create 100 - 32, 33, 38, 39.

x414 Chris → Finished profiling yesterday. W & N walls. Create 100 - 25, 27, 29, 30.

Both x413 & 14 were excavated to 100 cm db.

x415 Dan → Just starting NEO L6. Getting sealayer IPI'able base and see lithics. SWQ h-5 had lots of lithics, incl. scraper.

x416 Leslie → Working on S&E L6. Should have this level exposed at the same time as Dan. would be a good photo. IPI'able base ~~is~~ probably post-dated, producing lithics. She cannot stand in Chris's unit to excavate.

Friday June 17/05

Yesterday I did Ladies LBSWQ and got most of the way through to Dave's LBSWQ. Tars in Hales in Dan's unit. I better capture on notes for Graham's site.

x41 Michelle -> Working on last quad of LBSWQ. Mandible, tarsals, radius, ribs, etc perforated. Lots of flakes in SWQ, but less sp. able bare. Soil strias along E wall. LB should be most of the bare coming out, but some will be in L9.

x42 Mike -> Finishing up LBSWQ. Finding more flakes than there are any other. Together in those three units they've found at least 5 calms.

x43 Becky -> Ribs, tarsals, acetabulum, humerus. What does it all mean? "There were some very unlucky bigun" says Becky. N stored from SWQ L8.

There are clearly both older and younger (or smaller) animals here. Some of the smaller stuff appears to be fused but I can't be sure until it's out of the ground.

x44 Lynette -> Most ~~being perforated~~ that was perforated has been pulled. There are several in the wall and across base that extend into the next level, but most is gone. Working on NWQ L7. Moving much faster.

x45 Katie -> NEQ L8. "It's naked" she says. I'm assuming she refers to the fact that all the bone is pulled. Power travelling.

Didn't get annotes done yesterday. Spent some time prebiting and screen-  
drawing. Got a few people finished off yesterday.

XU 10 Lauer -> started sand shoring yesterday in L9, is now partway through  
L14. The odd flake or bit here and there, but not much. She will be able  
to finish the unit today.

XU 11 Erica -> BC she found dark dirt at about 90cm db and wasn't out  
by 100cm db, we had her trench the south of the unit down to 140cm  
db. Still in it. It's very mottled, looks like a high spot in the water  
table to me. But it isn't visible in XU 13 or 14. So it must be even  
localized. Bev wants to use the post-hole digger to go deeper in the  
other two finished units (13 & 14), but I don't think there's much point.  
The only way to get a high spot in the water table is through a high spot  
in the subsurface topography. So, finding the same soil at deeper locations  
isn't going to tell us much more than we already know. That is, that  
the water table is lower at those other spots.

Erica has prebited her south and west walls yesterday with this.

XU 12 Denise -> Finished at 100cm db. Prebited N & E walls. I  
think I see evidence of an "E" in the cells.

XU 13 Erica -> Yesterday, she trenched the south half of her unit to  
120cm db. Didn't find the dark dirt.

x414 Chris → Trenched the north half of his unit to ~~130~~ 130 cm  
 deep looking for dark dirt. Didn't find it

x415 Pam → Finishing NWQ L7. Went down too deep in SEQ. Still  
 finding flakes. Ls rock (first sized) along N/S boundary between  
 NEQ/SEQ. Not sure what it is. A horizontal terrace along L wall.

x416 Leslie → Shovel shavings in L10. Didn't find too much in L9. Probably  
 in strip sand. Should get most of the sand below.
