

- fetal bones recovered in NWQ
- probable projectile base + large Cortex flakes also found in NWQ

June 19th

- 8:45 - Continuing the removal of bone from level 4
- Pictures taken GR 16 + 17


June 20th 7:45

- working on SE quadrant of level 4
- still finding only a majority of lithic flakes
for artifacts.
10:00 - amount of artifacts ↑ in size + amount - Found Preform PP, scrapers
June 25th /08 - large bone is appearing in level 5 - Calcaneum? and more flakes.

- 7:40 - backfill was completed on X0 47, 48, + 49
- traps were taken down
- beginning SW Q of level 5
appear to be finding cluster of 3 Asymmetric
Knives, PP, and also large flakes of
similar SRC. Could be one person
producing these.



June 26th /08

- Beginning excavations on the remainder of the southeast quadrant
- appear to have a cluster of FCR in the NW Quad of level 6




FCR - Granites, Feldspar + Quartzite
Type

- Level 7 + 8 contained little artifacts
- Auger test will be done on the floor of Level 8
- Bill & Kim have found brown Chal flakes, retouched, biface rejuvenation, prairie + plains projectile points
- they also have an inverted rib section.
- finished excavating XW 51
- wall picture profile was taken and it appears that there is a dark area in which the bison skull and also the FCR and Point cluster ~~was~~ were located.

- ⑩ Bill and I will Be excavating the last unit around the bison skull to gain more information

July 2nd

- Continuing excavation on XU52
- Level 5 contained - K.R.F. thumb scraper + other large flakes
- also contained Bison tooth + skull fragments
- Level 6 - contained a large heated SRC flake, FCR clusters, and also skull and more tooth clusters. One piece of FCR located right beside tooth. Also found limestone in NW corner.

July 3/08

- began Shovel Shaving XU52 Level 7
- NE quad was sterile
- SE, SW + NW showed little artifacts
- possible thumb scraper found (KRF) in SEQ
- Shovel shaved Level 8 + found less artifacts
- South wall did appear to show that at some point in time, something was buried and then refilled.



- anomaly contains layers of alternating matrix colours. (light + dark)

- may show evidence that Bison Skull was buried.

- trench was completed to see how deep pit went

- Pit dissipated two levels below -

- trench contained zero artifacts

- bottom of trench contained a high amount of solid iron oxides.


- auger was used to finish excavation
