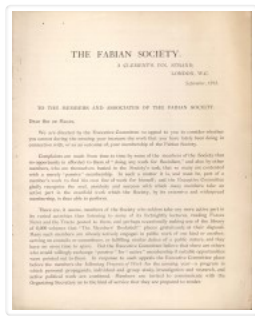

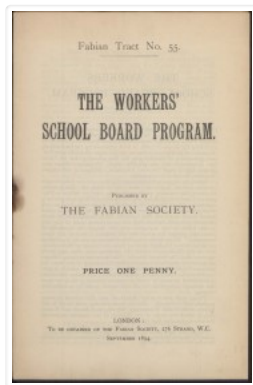

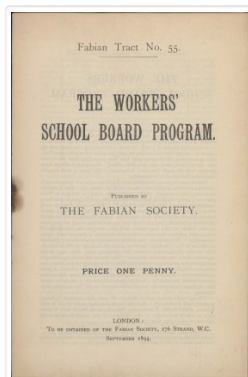


The workers' school board program

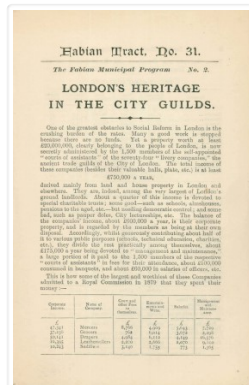


The Fabian municipal program. no. 2, London's heritage in the city guilds

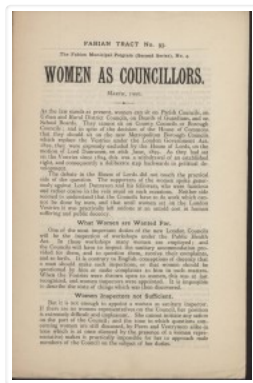

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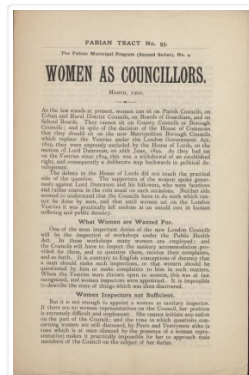


The Fabian umnicipal program (second series). no. 4, women as councillors
