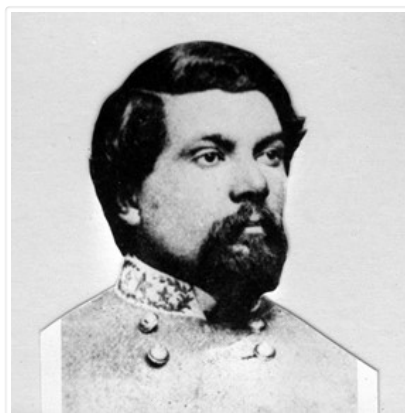

CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL. — Brandon Kiwanis Club has always been interested in the well-being of children, and in 1949 Kiwanists were proud of the \$30,000 renovation job they made possible on the isolation unit of Brandon General Hospital. Brandon Kiwanis raised \$13,000 (provincial grants supplied the balance) and the Kiwanis Children's Hospital was in business. Standing before the hospital are Kiwanis president (1949) A. V. Higgins and Mrs. Higgins (the couple on the right) and Mr. and Mrs. Norman McDonald (left). The separate hospital has since been replaced by the children's ward at Brandon General Hospital.
