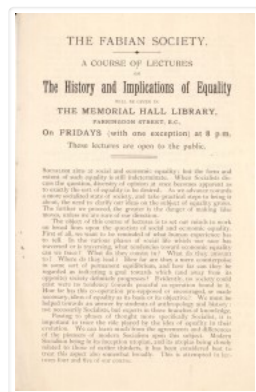

These lectures are open to the public.

Reverence aims at social and economic equality, but the form and extent of such equality is still indeterminate. When Socialism discusses the question, diversity of opinion is not because ignorance as to exactly the sort of equality to be desired. It is an absence of equality, a more extended state of equality, and the practical steps to bring it about, the need to study our ideas in the light of social progress. The lecture we present, the greater is the danger of making false claims, when we are not of our audience.

The object of this course of lectures is to set our minds to work on broad lines upon the question of social and economic equality. First of all, we want to be reminded of what human experience has to say. In the various phases of social life which our eyes see, the lecture is a warning. What influence might economic equality can we trace? What do they contain in? What do they contain in? What do they contain in? How far are they a more contemporary as some sort of permanent equilibrium, and how far can they be regarded as indicating a good remedy which, and even from its opposite, society already progresses? Secondly, we want to study that there are no tendency towards peaceful co-operation based in it. How far has this co-operation progressed or encouraged, or made progress towards equality in its form or its direction? We must be not necessarily realistic, but express these questions of knowledge.

Putting to phrase of thought more, especially Socialism, it is important to trace the idea of the idea of equality in their evolution. We can trace much from the agreement and differences of the phrases of modern Socialism upon this subject. Modern Socialism being in its infancy, it is not to be regarded as a solidified thing, but in its infancy, it has been considered how to trace the steps also extended locally. This is attempted in lectures four and five of our course.

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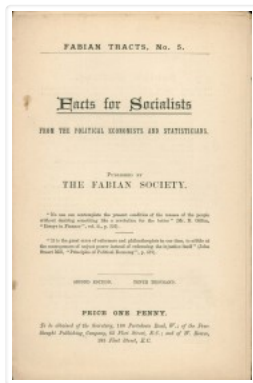

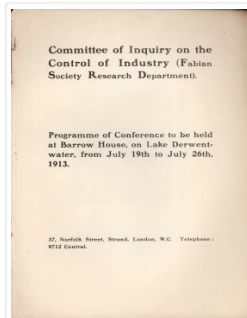


Programme of conference to be held at Barrow House, on Lake Derwentwater, from July 19th to July 26th, 1913

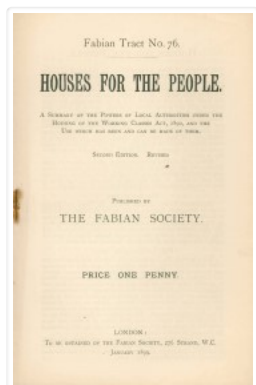

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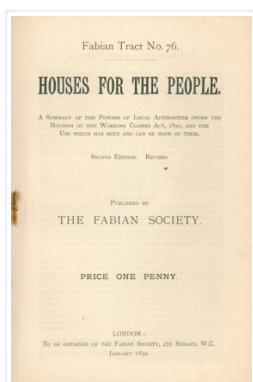
