Tell the Elevator Operator your Wheat is POOL WHEAT

You are a member of the Pool and you are, of course, entitled to the benefits of the Pool. But you must first tell the Elevator Operator that your wheat is Pool wheat. If you do not, your wheat will be treated as non-pool wheat and you will not receive the benefits of the Pool. To tell the Elevator Operator that your wheat is Pool wheat, you must fill out a "Wheat Card" and give it to him. The "Wheat Card" is a small card which you can get from the Pool Office. It contains a space for you to write the name of the farmer who raised the wheat, the name of the farmer who sold it to you, and the name of the farmer who bought it from you. You must also give the Elevator Operator the "Wheat Card" when you deliver your wheat to the Pool. This will enable him to give you the benefits of the Pool. If you do not give him the "Wheat Card", your wheat will be treated as non-pool wheat and you will not receive the benefits of the Pool.

Ship Wheat to the Pool

If you load over a grain loading platform at the Pool, you must first tell the Elevator Operator that your wheat is Pool wheat. If you do not, your wheat will be treated as non-pool wheat and you will not receive the benefits of the Pool. To tell the Elevator Operator that your wheat is Pool wheat, you must fill out a "Wheat Card" and give it to him. The "Wheat Card" is a small card which you can get from the Pool Office. It contains a space for you to write the name of the farmer who raised the wheat, the name of the farmer who sold it to you, and the name of the farmer who bought it from you. You must also give the Elevator Operator the "Wheat Card" when you deliver your wheat to the Pool. This will enable him to give you the benefits of the Pool. Wheat Pooling for Pool

The Pool Office has a plan for wheat pooling. This plan enables farmers to pool their wheat and receive the benefits of the Pool.
