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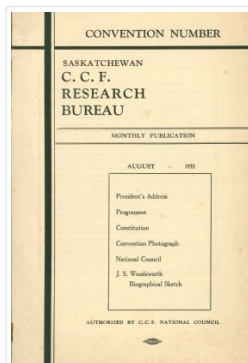


First annual C.C.F. convention, Regina, July 19, 20, 21, 1933

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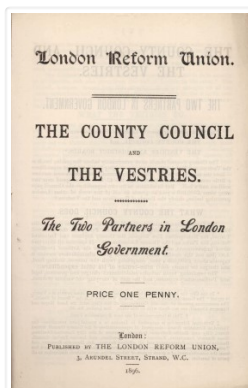


The county council and the vestries : the two partners in London government

Biographical:

John Duncan McDonald was born on April 30, 1893 in Brandon, MB. He attended Winterton and Basswood schools. John married Margaret Emily Greer (1894-1980) in the Greer home in the Moline district in 1917. Together they had four children: Sadie Julia Elva, Robert James, John Elmer and Roy Peter. From 1919-1965, he farmed at Basswood, MB on SW 36-14-20. John McDonald died on January 11, 1989. He is buried at Basswood Cemetery.

Custodial History:

As part of the Westman Oral History Collection, this collection was accessioned by the McKee Archives in 1998. The original tapes from the Westman Oral History project were deposited in the Brandon Public Library. Copies of these originals were made by Margaret Pollex of the Brandon University Language Lab at the request of Eileen McFadden, University Archivist in the early 1990s. These copies compose the collection held in the McKee Archives.

Question: This is an Gordon Shanks of Brandon interview for volume of Westman Oral History Collection. Today is November 11, 1981, the following is an interview with John McDonald a retired farmer from Brandon now living in Upper Garden in Rapid City.

Q: Mr. McDonald at what grade did you go to school at your grandparents?

Answer: Well, my grandparents are my father's side come from, they were from a British background and came to Canada when my father was six months old.

Q: So when was the date, Mr. McDonald?

A: Around 1880, and at that time it was around at Brandon District, that at my mother's time father and mother came from Scotland and all they were all they worked around Brandon District, around at Old Garden in Brandon, and all.

Q: Mr. McDonald at what grade did you go to school at your grandparents?

A: Well, my grandfather was a general store for trade and he worked at that until he passed away and the cause of his death was from the heat of the weather during that time after my father worked on farm, my grandfather and the rest of the family moved out here, and at my grandfather and at my time came from here for about ten years.
