On 16 November 1906, Manitoba was hit by a severe winter storm that began that Thursday evening and extended through the weekend. CPR trains had been caught in drifts by Carberry and an express car had caught fire and was destroyed ("Worst Storm in Many Years," Brandon Daily Sun, 19 Nov. 1906, 1).
