Biographical:

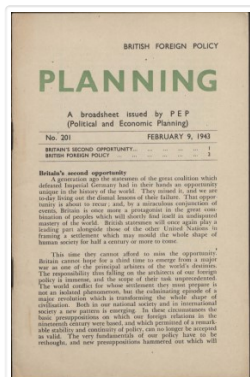
