Denise Ens instructed the school and James Graham was teaching assistant. Field journals were kept by both instructors.

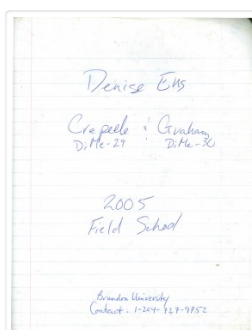
