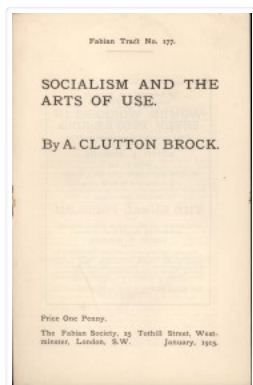

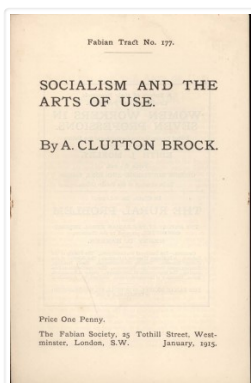

### Scope and Content:
