Biographical:

Morris Predinchuk was a professional photographer, who during the period 1987-1999, was retained by Brandon University to photograph convocations and graduates. Each of the personal portraits was the product of a contract between Predinchuk and a graduate for a graduation photograph. Morris Predinchuk died in Moosomin, Saskatchewan on January 16, 2007 at the age of 75 years.

Custodial History:

The images were picked up by the Archives from Predinchuk's business in the Towne Centre Mall on September 27, 2005.

Scope and Content:

Sub-series consists of negatives and prints of approximately 2600 graduates and honorary degree recipients at Brandon University spring and fall convocations from 1987-1998 and the spring convocation of 1999. All the images were taken by Morris Predinchuk.

Notes: For descriptive purposes it was decided to group the negatives by convocation rather than describing each individual negative.
Predinchuk's obituary appeared in the January 19, 2007 edition of the Brandon Sun.
