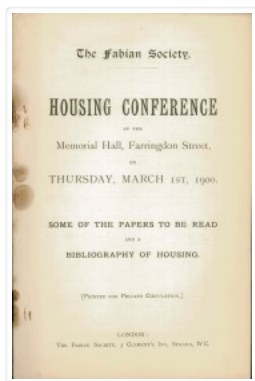

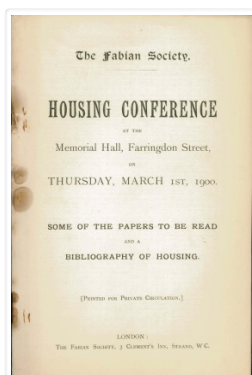


Housing conference at the Memorial Hall, Farringdon Street, March 1st, 1900

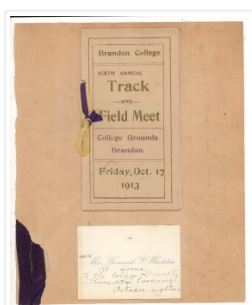

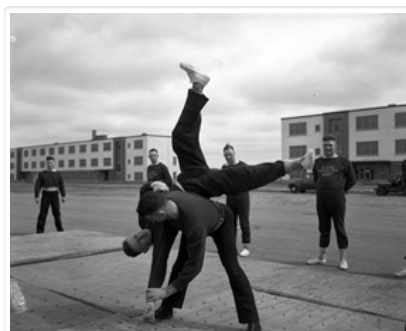
