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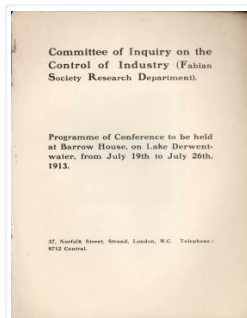


Programme of conference to be held at Barrow House, on Lake Derwentwater, from July 19th to July 26th, 1913

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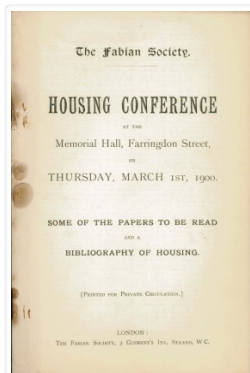


Housing conference at the Memorial Hall, Farringdon Street, March 1st, 1900
