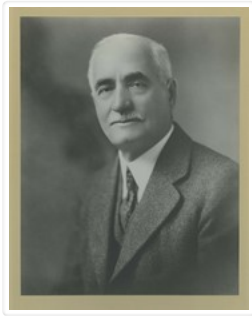

Photograph is a portrait of Franklin W. Sweet, Brandon College President (1923-1924).

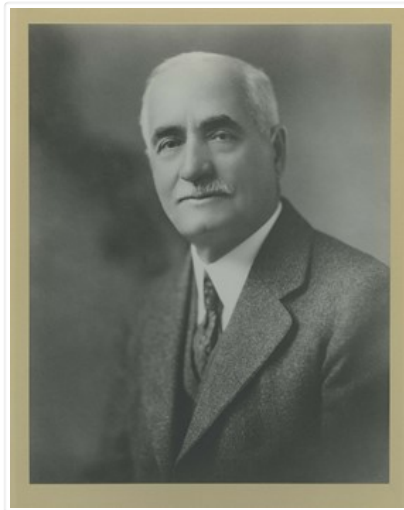
