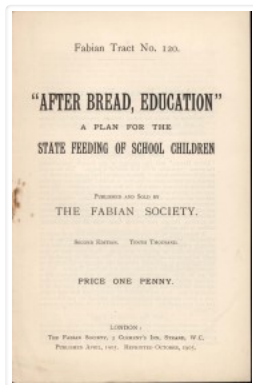

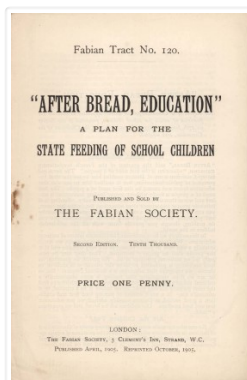


After bread education : a plan for the state feeding of school children
