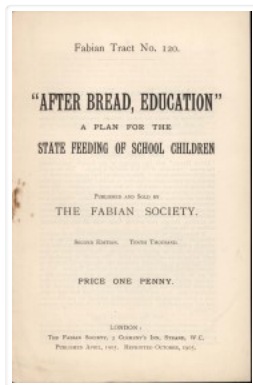

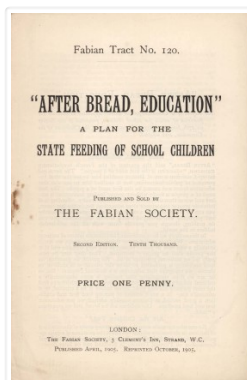

History /

Biographical:

John Dickson (b. 17 Mar 1854, Scotland; d.15 April 1926, Brandon) was considered one of Brandon's pioneer dentists. Dickson immigrated to Canada in 1857, where he lived in Hamilton, Ontario, for a number of years. Dickson then came to Manitoba and operated a grocery in Chater before he studied dentistry, graduating from the University of Minnesota in 1886. Dickson settled in Brandon where he married Anna Louise Harrison on 28 December 1891. (Source: "Pioneer Dentist of Brandon in Dr. John Dickson," Brandon Daily Sun 16 Apr 1926)

The couple had four children: Mrs. Irving Cross [Mary Louise, b.20 Dec 1892, Brandon; d. 22 Oct 1981, Saratoga, NY]; Dr. John Harrison Dickson [b. 26 Aug 1894, Brandon; d. 17 June 1956, Killarney]; Dr. Stanley Rodgers Dickson [b. 18 Feb 1896, Brandon; d. 25 July 1963, Brandon]; and Mrs. Emile Baldeschweiler [Isobel Marion Coates, b. 13 Nov 1900, Brandon; d.?] of New York. CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL. — Brandon Kiwanis Club has always been interested in the well-being of children, and in 1949 Kiwanians were proud of the \$30,000 improvement job they made possible on the isolation unit of Brandon General Hospital. Brandon Kiwanis raised \$13,000 (provincial grants supplied the balance) and the Kiwanis Children's Hospital was in business. Standing before the hospital are Kiwanis president (1949) A. V. Higgins and Mrs. Higgins (the couple on the right) and Mr. and Mrs. Norman McDonald (left). The separate hospital has since been replaced by the children's ward at Brandon General Hospital.
