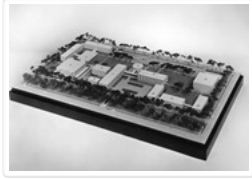

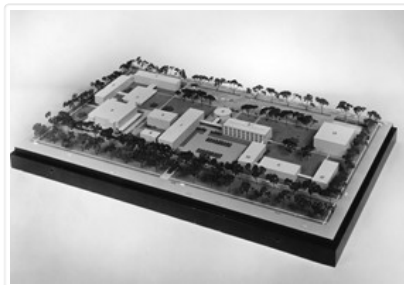
Biographical:
