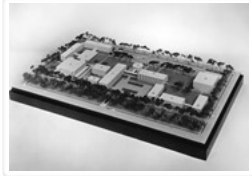

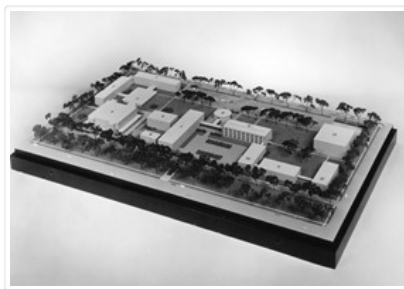
Biographical:
