
Arrived at Graham site at 08:40

The NEQ and SEQ, marked with golf tees.





06-16-08

Finally a bright sunny morning.
Will begin to excavate the SWQ using
the trawl method at 5 cm levels using
1/8 inch dry screenings.

The SWQ has a large root running
North West.

The time is 09:00 hrs,

Level 3 10-15 cm dbs completed at
12:30 hrs

A large amt of large bones appear at
the NWQ on floor of the 10-15 cm level.

June 17, 2008

Arrived at the Graham Site D.Mc 30 at 08:45 and it's going to be a warm one today

I will be finishing the SEQ level 4 although excavation will be slow due to the amount of bone at the floor of level 4. 15-20 cm

Excavation will be done using trowel method with 1/8" dry screening.

Andrew is at XU 48 and is also at the SEQ 4th level. Andrew appears to have a two mandibles poss three.

Kim is at XU 49, she is at the SWQ level 4, there are scattered bone clusters in her unit.

The SWQ has a cluster of bone in the centre of quad. (bone frags)

June 18, 08

XU 47 Dime 30 Grohem site


Arrived at site at 08:45 The weather is warm, partly sunny skies, medium breeze.

I will continue excavating the SWQ using the trowel method, dry screenings with $\frac{1}{8}$ " mesh.

Removed bone cluster from NWQ as mentioned above. Cluster may be part of large bone prob numerous bone found beneath cluster.

A medium size brad plate found in SWQ provenienced 64 s / 84 w 19 cm db.

The NWQ was producing a small amt of skull frags situated at the south centre part of the quad. see diagram below.

June 19, 08

There was a bit of fog this morning near the town of Louder other wise the sun was breaking through by the time we arrived at the site, which was about 08:45. had to stop in Louder for water for washings.

I will be continuing to excavate the NWQ using the trowel method and dry screenings with $\frac{1}{8}$ " mesh. Excavation will continue to be at a turtles pace due to the large amount of bone present.

at this point Andrew is removing bone from his finished level, level 4. A photo was taken of his floor.

Kim is at the 5th level and half way through her NEQ, she is using a trowel for now, but she said she will probably be shovel shoveling very soon.

Yesterday Kim found a beautiful bi-face tool but was broken in half or so, it was found in her SWQ at level 4.

June 20, 2008

Arrived at Graham Site at 07:45, Bright sunny morning. Started to remove ~~pedastated~~ pedastated bone from unit at level 4 15-20cm db's Kim was assisting me yesterday. I will continue today by my lonesome, I will be using the trowel method with 1/8" dry screening.

Kim and Bev are at the Creepole site setting up a new dig.

I found a utilized KRF tool very large with a thick cortex on both sides. It was found between a small amount of bone in the SEQ near the south wall of my unit.

June 21, 2008

I arrived at the site on Saturday 16:00hrs
Graham site DiMe 30 5725 704w XU 47.

On the way I noticed Kims unit was partly
uncovered, she did not cover her unit properly. I
recovered it and placed the screen over it.

Today I will continue to remove the remainder
of pedistated bone from level 4 18-20 cm dbs. NWQ.

There were a total of 11 artifact bags used
for the remainder.

One interesting artifact was a very small
tooth probably un-erupted.

most bones were identifiable however there were
a couple that I could not I.D.

Finished level 4 at 20:00 hrs. A picture
was taken by my camera.

June 23, 2008

Arrived at the Graham Site DiMe 30 XU 47
5725 704w at 08:45 - Cloudy conditions with
slight breeze it is supposed to rain today 5mm.

I will begin excavation on level 5 20-25 cm
dbs, I will be using the power trowel method
and screening dry with 1/8" screen, there is
still a small amt of bone in floor of level 4,

Finished level 5 20-25 cm dbs. There is still the
odd bit of bone protruding from the floor and walls.

There is a medium size rock (TESHOA) in the
floor of the SWQ which I will provenience and
remove. No picture was taken of floor of
level 5.

There is a small root in the NWQ, the
floor is described as darker sandy loam at the
East side of the unit and along the edge of
the North wall. Light sandy soil at on the
West side darkening towards the centre of
the unit. see diagram below



June 24, 2008

Graham Site DiMe 30 572s/704w

Arrived at the site at 08:45 bright sunny morning slight breeze. I will be shovel shoveling my unit today and screening with 1/8" dry screen hoping to find one gigantic pot, and maybe a clavis point, lol!

Beu had to go back into town to fix his leaking sink

Finished Unit XU47 no wall profile was done but photo was taken of South wall.

The unit was finished at level 8 35-40 cm db. only 2 bone frags were found, which was in the SWQ.

I will be helping Kim at XU-50 DiMe 29 Creeple site.

Kim is at level 8 at the SEQ. I will begin excavating level 5 NWQ. 20-25 cm db.

06-25-08

Arrived at the Creeple site at 07:45 cool sunny morning. The first job was to back fill in the units at the Graham site, and take down the canopy. I left tobacco in my unit and a penny was placed in by Bev.

At the Creeple I will continue excavating XU.50 NWQ level 5 25-30cm db. The trowel method will be used and screening dry with 1/8" screen.

Kim is excavating the SEQ at some unit Andrew is excavating at unit XU.51 he is presently at level 5 SWQ.

Finished SWQ many bones, plates, 3 pos ceramic sherds, and one large rock with noticable pecking on ends.

I will now begin the NEQ. The NEQ was previously excavated by Kim and the 9th level ~~15~~ 20-25 cm db was only at 22 cm db.

Kim found a side notched ~~arrow~~ projectile point in the quad I was excavating NWQ after literally ripping out a root from her quad SWQ. The root ran into the NWQ, the projectile point then became uncovered. Later she found another one it was beautifully made. It was a side notched made from KRF, looked like it was never used.

06-26-08

Arrived at the Creepe site unit 50 at 07:45

Cloudy do morning, no wind.

I will be continuing to excavate the NEQ level 6 25-30 cm. dbs. The trowel method will be used and $\frac{1}{8}$ " dry screening.

I haven't been finding much except for small amounts of 2D bone, 3 pot sherds, 1 med rock with pedicels, and small bone frags, and flakes.

A rib was found on the floor of level 6 was provenanced (SEQ 465/665/23 bs)

it was partially into the East wall, another rib situated on the NWQ was vertical. The vertical rib was left in situ and at level 6 I removed the pedicel.

The soil directly around pedicel bone is dark grey in colour. The rib was removed in 5 fragmented pieces, rib extended to the floor of level 7.

June 27-08

Arrived at Crepeole site at 07:45 cleaned up some of the site. Carried gear back to the truck, Sunny windy day

Started a new unit with Andrew XU-52 533s @ 75w finish up at level 4 15-20 cm dss., using the trowel method, Dry screens with $\frac{1}{8}$ " mesh

Went to find a new site unit for a latter day with Bev. Somebody screwed up in their recording, could not find the proper unit number. I'll be back.

July 01, 2008

Arrived at the Graham Site at 549 s / 748 w XU-53. Very hot sunny day arrived at 11:30 with my wife Brender and grandson Hadden. They helped with carrying gear to site location and they also helped with the construction of a canopy over the unit.

The original unit I had chosen to excavate was changed due to fact that I should of actually located it before putting up canopy. So instead of moving canopy over about 4 feet, I decided to excavate a unit just north of original location, I only hope the big boss doesn't mind.

Finished the canopy and cleared some sod of the unit, there was lots of sand mixed in with the sod, probably because that particular unit was under the screen from a previous excavation.

left the Graham site at 15:30 hrs. still hot, Temp was +25C in bush and +31 out of bush.

July 02, 2008

Arrived at the Graham Site 549s/748w XU-53 at 10:00, partly cloudy with a slight breeze.


I will be using the trowel method and dry screening with $\frac{1}{8}$ " mesh.

I will continue to remove the sod layer from unit.

Andrew is continuing to excavate at his unit XU-52,

level 1+2 completed 0-10 cm dbs no artifacts were found.

SWQ Lev 3 10-15 cm dbs bone and FCR are present on floor, 1 bone frag cluster at North ctr part of Quad, FCR at SE corner and E ctr part of quad. at the SE corner a rib and UnID bone are lying out Northwest from crumbled FCR. see diagram below



July 03, 08

Arrived at the Graham Site XU-53 DiMc 30
549s/748w, Bright sunny morning. Finished
level 3 10-15 cm dbs yesterday except for
the bone left on floor of level.

I will be doing a level summary sheet and
will be taking a photograph.

A large radius (distal) was found in the SWQ
and was provenanced, photographed and wrapped in
tin foil for RC.

Andrew finished his unit and back filled it.
He also took down the tarp and cleaned up.

Completed level 4 15-20 cm dbs and a photo was taken.

Beginning level 5 20-25 cm dbs, The SEQ + SWQ
are finished not much found except for
bone frags and small retouch flakes.

July 04, 08

Arrived at the Graham site, sunny and windy
I'm going to finish the level 5 using a trowel
and will be shovel shoveling further levels,
dry screening with 1/8" screen.

Unit finished, ~~the~~ trenched with Auger to 90 cm dbs
at the SW corner no artifacts found
Will now do unit summary.
