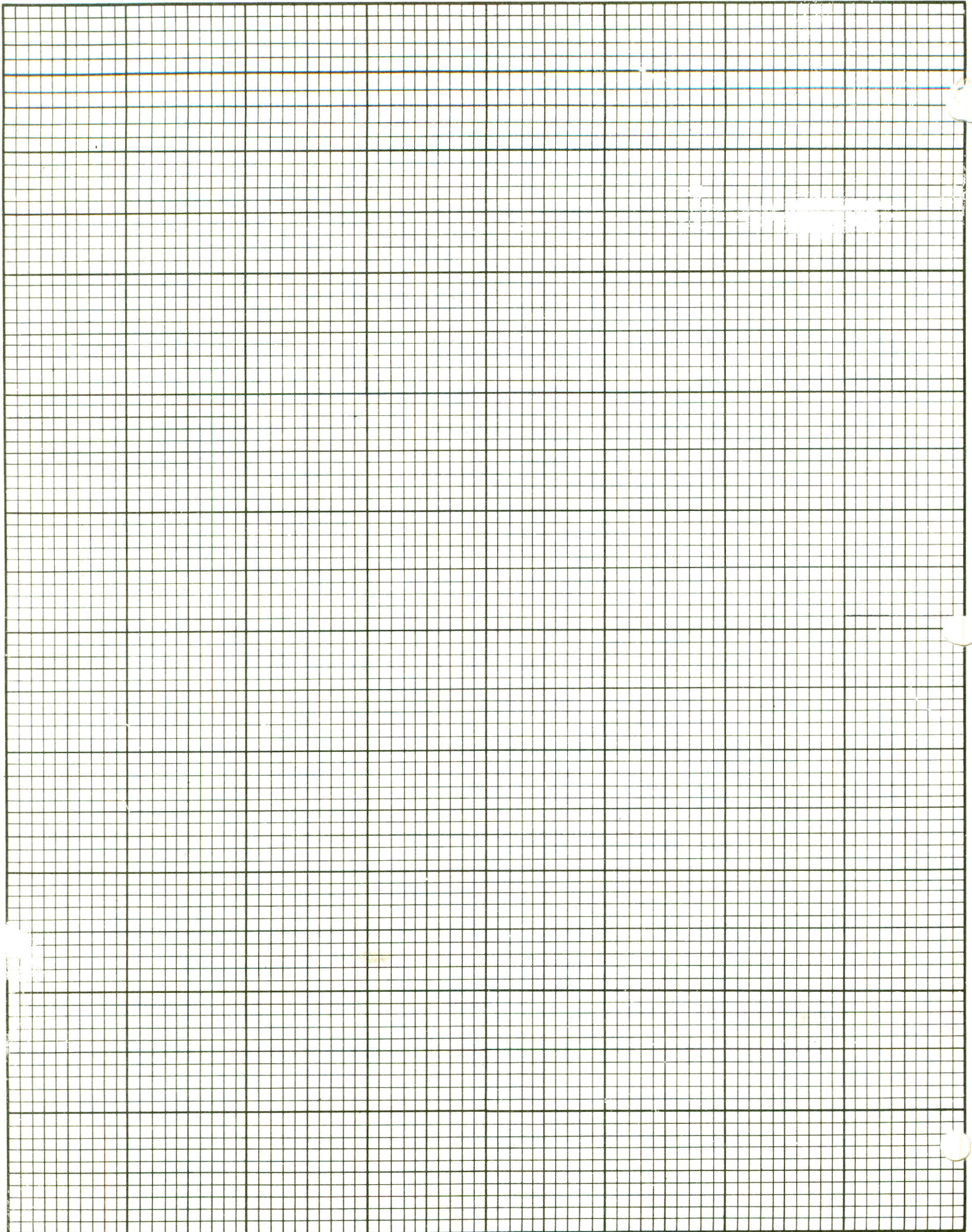

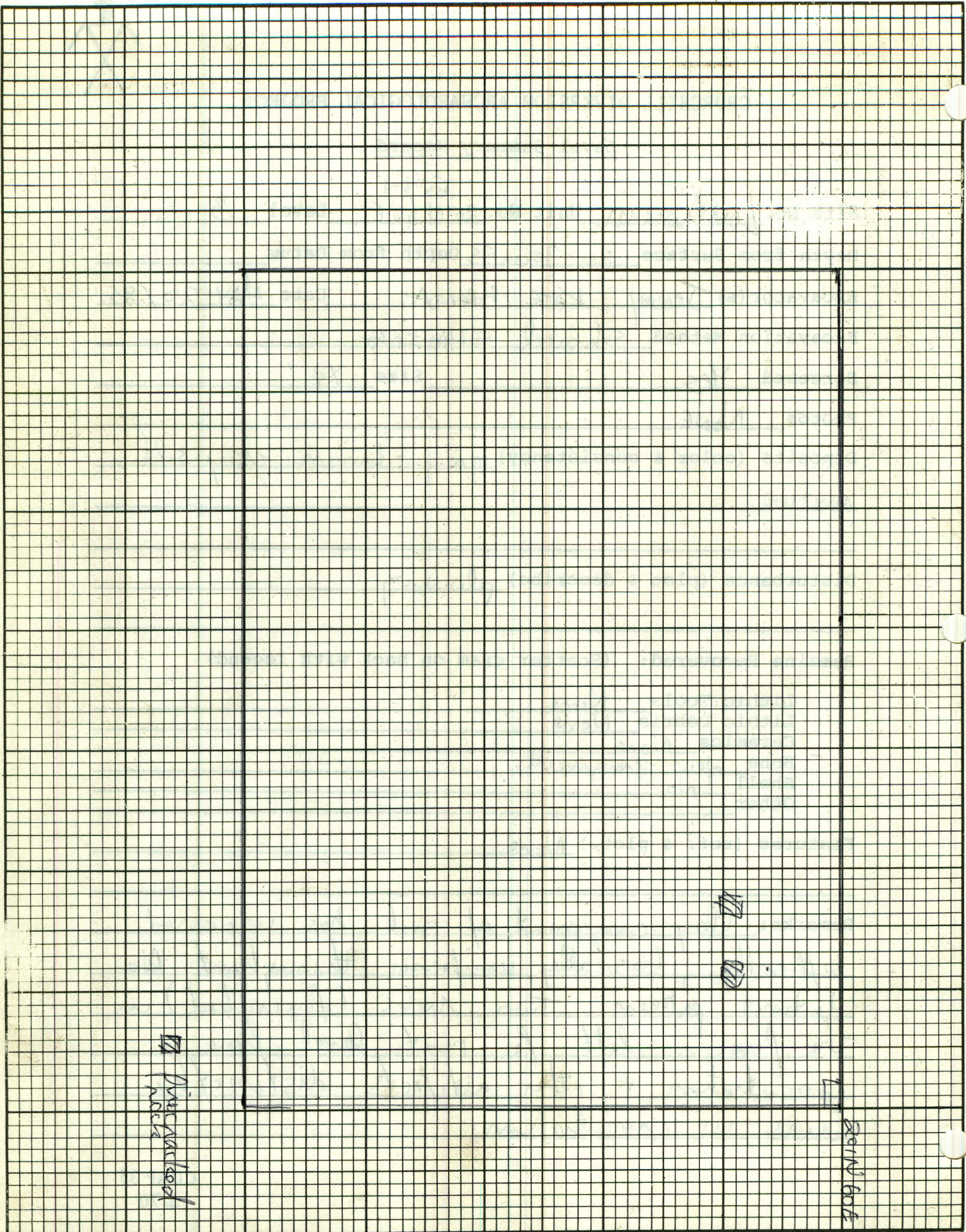

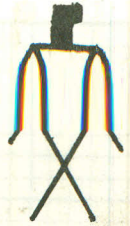


Pusat asid

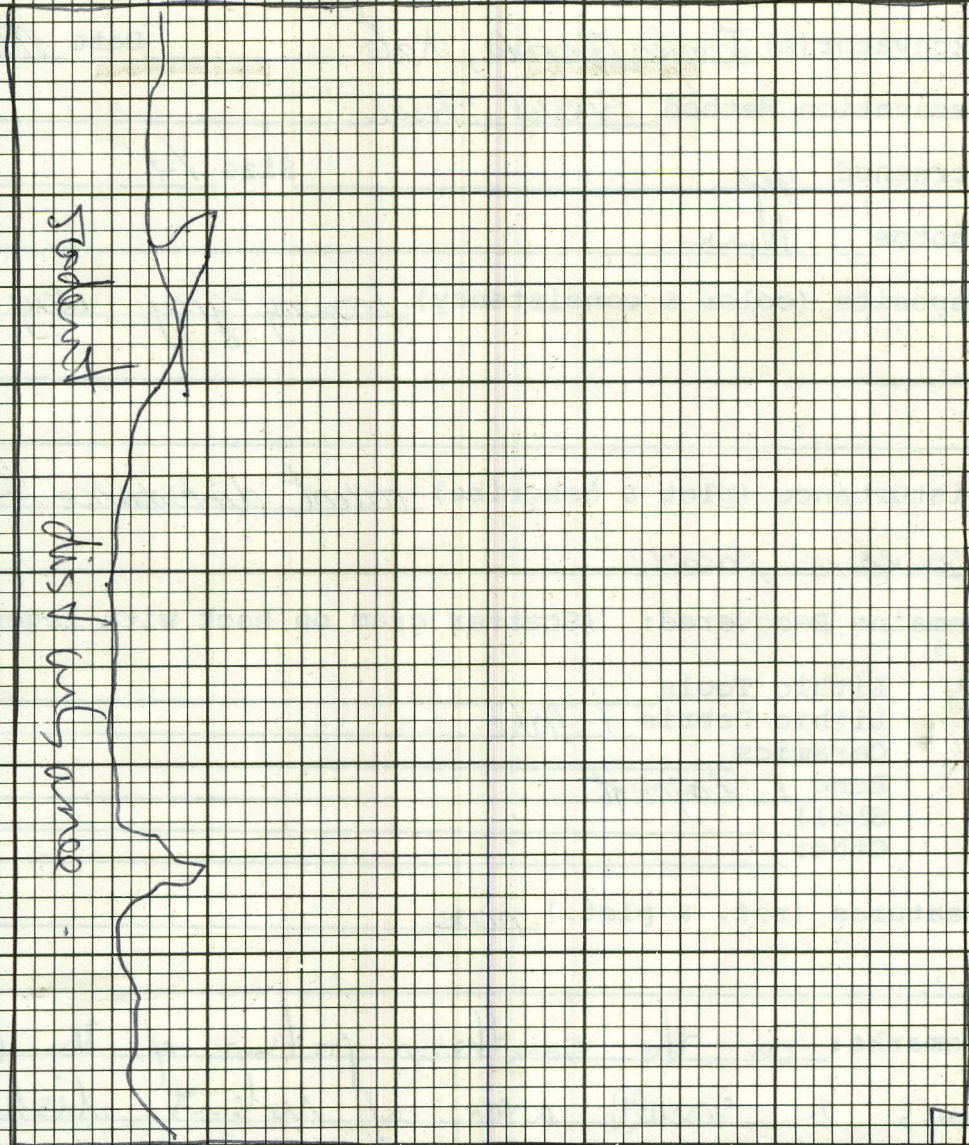
