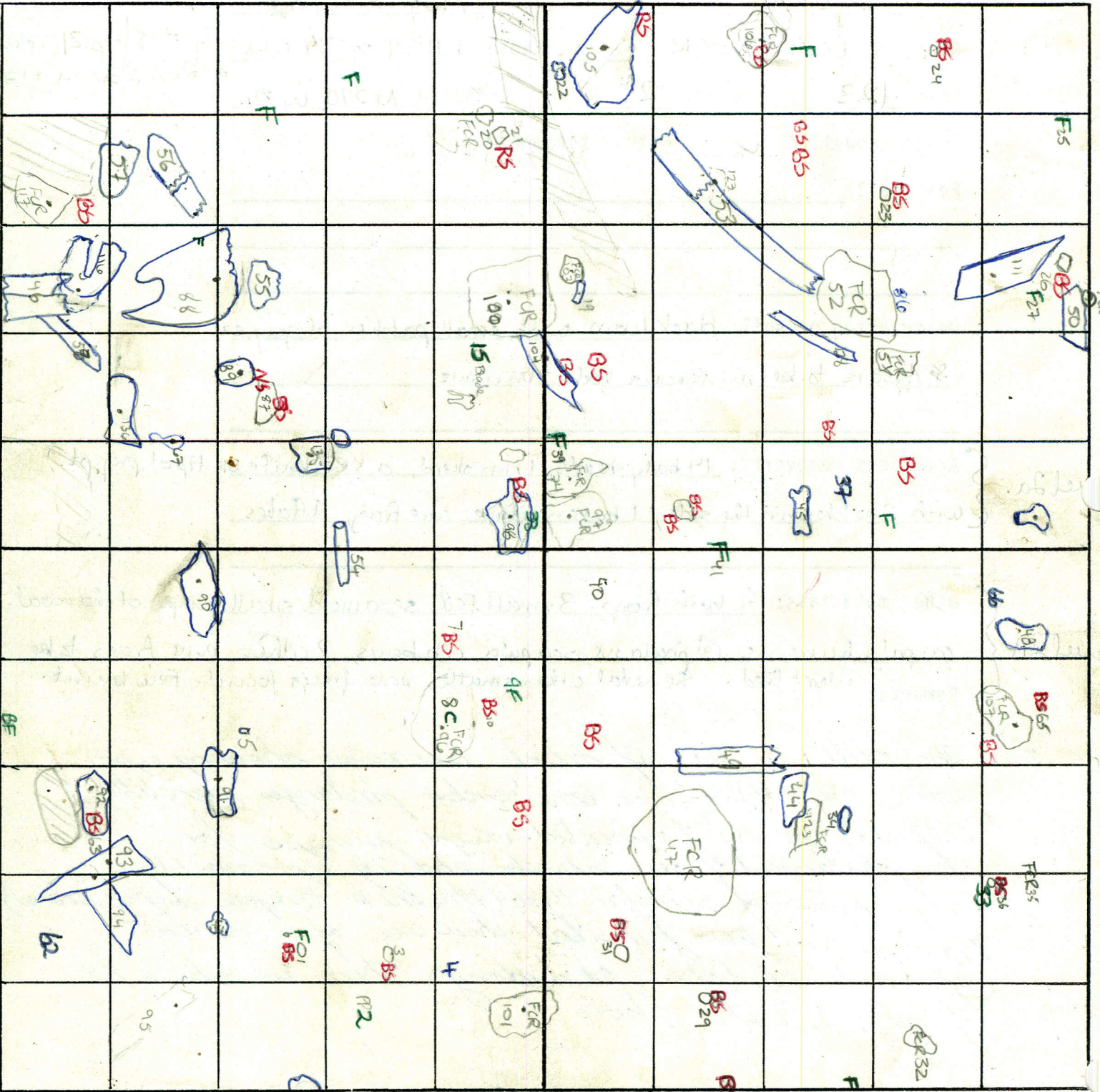

Level 2B - still a lot of rodent burrows showing up - see map. Also, more bone - ribs, phalanges, mandible, scapula - mostly fragmented, except perhaps for the phalanges. More sherds showing up - mostly body sherds, of similar type (Kipitons, temper, impressions). ~~There~~ There are few flakes, but these are of a variety of materials (chert, chalcedony...). There are also a lot of roots in the floor.

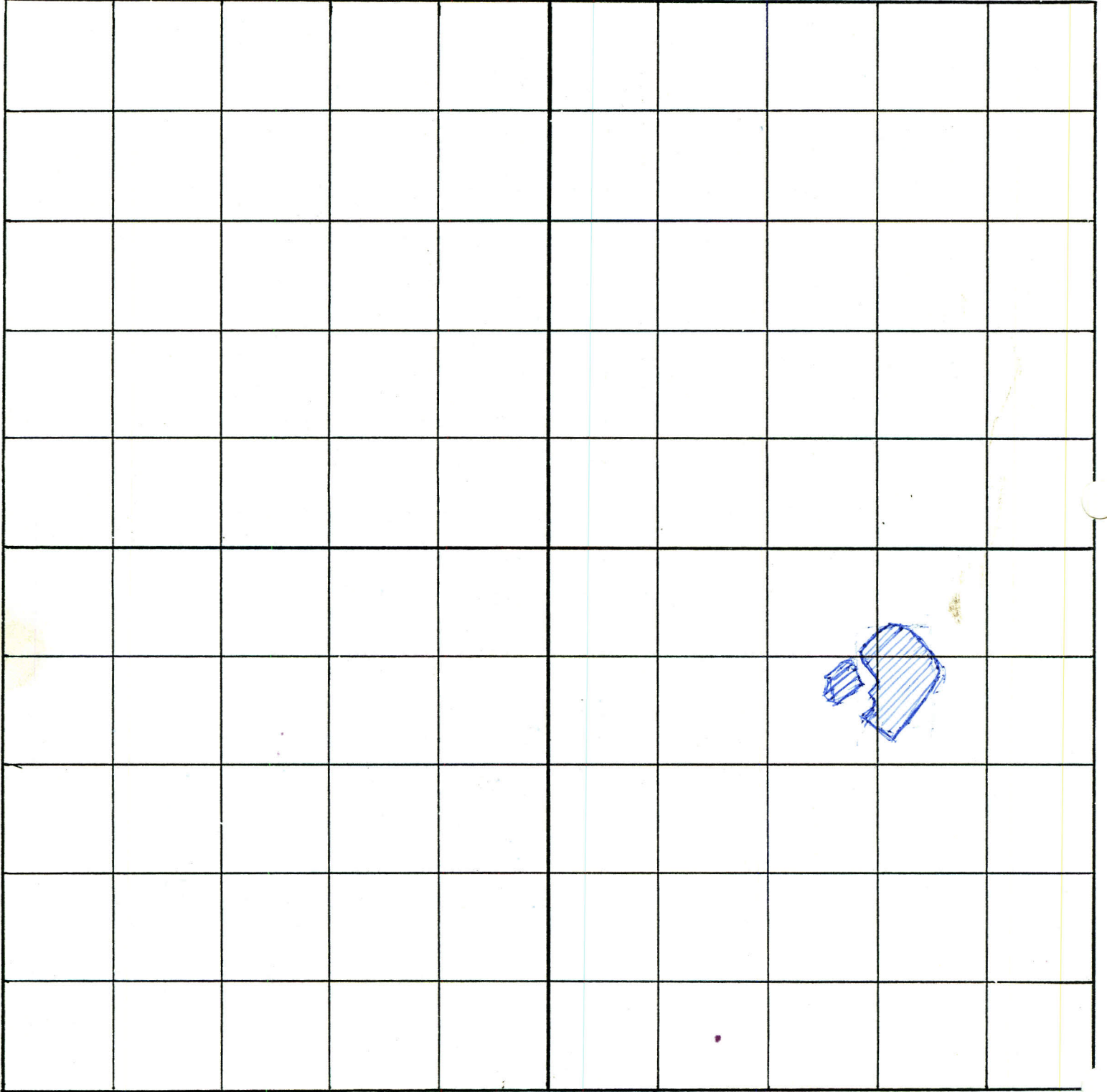
