DEAR SIR,

I am directed by the Executive Committee of the Fabian Society to inform you that several of its lecturers have arranged to visit Lancashire during the month of September next, in order to deliver a course of lectures in Manchester, and to fulfil engagements to lecture to Working Men's Clubs. Co-operative Societies, Liberal and Radical Associations, etc., on subjects connected with Socialism and the Labor movement.

The enclosed Lecture List will afford some idea of the scope of these lectures, of which over one thousand were delivered last year.

The lecturers in all cases give their services gratuitously, but payment of travelling expenses is usually required. As, however, several of the lecturers will be in or near Manchester during practically the whole of September, they will be able to accept invitations from any public body within a reasonable distance of that city absolutely free of any expense whatever. Lectures can probably be arranged for during October also.

An exceptional opportunity is therefore offered to Political Associations, Co-operative Societies, Working Men's Clubs and other organisations to provide their members with interesting and instructive lectures without cost, and it is hoped that the services of the lecturers will be made as much use of as possible.
